Guidelines

Video Requirements

- The final video must be 30–60 seconds in length.
-
- The video must be submitted in MP4 format.
-
- The video must be created as an animation or cartoon.
-
- You may use any animation software or website (e.g., Canva Cartoon Maker).
-
- AI tools are allowed, but all scientific content must be original and created by the student.
-
- A voice-over is required, and it must be recorded by the student submitting the video.
-
- The video must end with the phrase:

“And that’s Food Science in One-Minute!”

- Please name your video file using your first name followed by your last name (e.g., John Smith Video.mp4)

Research Content Requirements

- Submit a 3–5 sentence description of the research featured in your video.
-
- Undergraduate students must include the name of their graduate student mentor and/or PI.
-
- Graduate students must include the name of their PI.
-

Submissions that do not meet the minimum requirements may not be accepted or forwarded to the judging panel.
